Victorian Farmers Federation - application for authorisation A91534 - interested party consultation

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) is currently consulting on an application for authorisation received from Victorian Farmers Federation on 7 April 2016.

The purpose of this letter is to invite you, as a potentially interested party, to comment on the application. Please see our publication <u>Authorisation process - the basics</u> for a summary of the authorisation process and how to make a submission to the ACCC.

Application for authorisation

Victorian Farmers Federation seeks authorisation on behalf of current and future members of chicken growers groups to collectively bargain with chicken meat processers for:

- growing fees and other terms and conditions of chicken growing contracts;
- adjustment and review of growing fees and other matters arising from time to time under/or in relation to terms of chicken growing contracts;
- resolution of disputes which from time to time arise under chicken growing contracts or otherwise arise between the processor and a grower or growers.

These chicken growers groups provide growing services for chicken meat processers, Baida Poultry Pty Ltd, Hazeldene Chicken Farm Pty Ltd, Ingham Enterprises Pty Ltd and Turi Foods Farming Division Pty Ltd.

Background

The ACCC previously granted authorisation for Victorian Farmers Federation current and future member growers to engage in collective bargaining with the chicken meat processors to whom they supplied growing services. Authorisation was granted until 12 May 2015.

Request for submissions

The ACCC invites you to make a submission on the likely public benefits and effect on competition, or any other public detriment, from the proposed arrangements.

Further, the ACCC invites you to outline your general experience of the collective bargaining arrangements during the term of the previous authorisation. The ACCC would also welcome your views on the public benefits and detriments you consider have actually resulted from the collective bargaining arrangements during the previous authorisation period.

If you intend to provide a submission on the application for authorisation please do so by **29 April 2016**. Submissions should be emailed to adjudication@accc.gov.au with the subject "A91534 – Victorian Farmers Federation – submission".

Alternatively, if you would like to provide comments orally, please contact Saraj Bhullar on (03) 9290 1941 to organise a suitable time.

Submissions, including oral submissions, will be placed on the ACCC's public register subject to any request for exclusion. Please see the ACCC's publication <u>Guidelines for excluding information from the public register</u>.
