Third line forcing notification – Telstra – proposed offers to ‘Stayz property owners’

Further to the third line forcing notification lodged by Telstra Corporation Limited (**Telstra**) on 31 March 2016, we have set out some further information in relation to the offers Telstra is proposing to make to ‘Stayz property owners’.

Telstra is intending to offer ‘Stayz property owners’:

- a \$100 credit if they sign-up to an \$89 per month Home Broadband Bundle with Telstra on a 24 month plan. Customers do not need to repay the \$100 credit if they cancel before the end of their minimum term, however normal early termination charges will apply;
- a \$20 discount on a \$79 Pre-Paid Wi-Fi Plus Mobile Broadband product. This is a once-off transaction with the customer (as it is for a pre-paid product) and, as a result, customers will not be required to repay the \$20 discount after the completion of the transaction; and
- a \$30 discount on a \$119 Pre-Paid 4GX Wi-Fi Advanced 2 Mobile Broadband product. This is a once-off transaction with the customer (as it is for a pre-paid product), and, as a result, customers will not be required to repay the \$30 discount after the completion of the transaction.

Telstra consents to the publication of this letter on the ACCC’s public register along with the notification.
