Refrigerant Reclaim Australia – application A91515 for revocation and substitution of authorisation - determination

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has issued a determination granting conditional re-authorisation to Refrigerant Reclaim Australia Ltd and others to continue to operate a scheme to recover ozone-depleting and synthetic-greenhouse-gas refrigerants. Re-authorisation is subject to conditions that RRA continue to publish certain information about its effectiveness on its website.

The ACCC re-authorises the conduct for a further five years, until 28 May 2021.

A copy of the ACCC's determination is **attached**.

Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the Competition and Consumer Act 2010, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal (the Tribunal) for a review of the determination. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 27 May 2016. If no application for a review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 28 May 2016.

An application for a review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Tribunal. The Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
