Western Australian Broiler Growers' Association Inc application for revocation of authorisation A91262 and substitution of new authorisation A91527 – determination

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has granted authorisation in respect of the application for authorisation lodged by the Western Australian Broiler Growers' Association (WABGA) on 15 February 2016.

A copy of the ACCC's determination and summary of its reasons is attached.

For the reasons set out in its determination, the ACCC has granted authorisation for 10 years.

Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010*, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal (the Tribunal) for a review of the determination. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 21 June 2016. If no application for a review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 22 June 2016.

An application for a review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Tribunal. The Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
