Third line forcing notification N99174 - Gozleme Kings Co. Franchising Pty Ltd

I refer to the notification you lodged with the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) on behalf of Gozleme Kings Co. Franchising Pty Ltd (Gozleme Kings) on 27 June 2016. The protection from legal action provided by the notification commences automatically 14 days after the lodgement date, unless the ACCC objects.

On the basis of the information that you have provided, and that Gozleme Kings will disclose all relevant terms and conditions to customers, the ACCC does not object to the notification at this time.

If at any time circumstances change, or the ACCC receives further information, such that it is satisfied that the public benefits from the third line forcing conduct do not outweigh the public detriments, the ACCC may remove the protection provided by the notification.

I have also considered your request that the attachment accompanying the notification be excluded from the ACCC's public register.

As you are aware, the ACCC is generally required under section 95 of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (the Act) to place documents provided to it in relation to a notification on the ACCC's public register. The Act provides that a person submitting a document in relation to a notification may request that the document or parts thereof be excluded from the public register by reason of the nature of certain information contained in the document.

As a person authorised to make a decision for and on behalf of the ACCC in relation to such a request, I advise that the attachment will not be placed on the public register.

This letter has been placed on the ACCC's public register.
