Application for Minor Variation to South Australian Chamber of Mines and Energy Authorisations A91567 & A91568—determination

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has issued a determination varying authorisations A91567 & A91568.

Authorisations A91567 & A91568 were originally granted by the ACCC on 17 May 2017. The minor variation sought by SACOME involves amending the list of participating members to remove Arrium Ltd and add relevant subsidiaries of Arrium that would enter into any electricity supply agreements arising out of negotiations by the joint electricity purchasing group.

A copy of the ACCC's determination is attached.

Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010*, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal (the Tribunal) for a review of the determination. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 6 September 2017. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 7 September 2017.

An application for review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Tribunal. The Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
