The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has issued a determination varying authorisation A91388.

Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the Competition and Consumer Act 2010, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal (the Tribunal) for a review of the determination. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 24 March 2017. If no application for a review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 25 March 2017.

An application for a review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Tribunal. The Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
