We are writing to you in relation to the application for re-authorisation lodged by the Shopping Centre Council of Australia on 11 September 2020.

Section 4.3 of the application states that re-authorisation is sought in relation to a lessening of competition or contracts, arrangements or understandings that restrict dealings or affect competition (section 45).

We note that the existing authorisations (A91591 and A91592) were granted in relation to conduct that may contain a cartel provision or may have the purpose or effect of substantially lessening competition within the meaning of section 45 of the CCA. In relation to the current application, could you please clarify whether the Shopping Centre Council of Australia wishes to include conduct that may contain a cartel provision, within the meaning of Division 1 of Part IV of the CCA, at section 4.3 (i.e. provisions for which reauthorisation is sought)?
