Interim Authorisation: Report of “material decisions” for week ending 26 June 2020

We are instructed that with respect to the meetings of the Special Working Group or its sub-committees (**Committees**) held last week, there is no report to give under para 3 of the Protocol of any material decision made by the Committees that falls within the Proposed Conduct.

We are instructed to provide the following update more generally:

Summary of matters discussed at the Committee meeting held last week

In brief, the following matters were addressed at the Committee meeting held last week:

- analysis of international network performance data from international carriers and organisations, including a focus on analysis of traffic peak growth and weekly volume growth (which suggested both continue to trend above pre-COVID-19 levels) and consideration of recent trends observed in Italy and Germany;
- analysis of recent **nbn** network performance data, including upstream and downstream traffic and usage patterns;
- discussion about the ongoing voluntary measures adopted by the main OTT videoconferencing providers and a proposal to undertake some further analysis to assess the ongoing impact of those measures and whether they continue to be required;
- discussion of the steps certain OTT video streaming providers are taking regarding the voluntary measures they had in place to help manage network traffic (following the SWG’s recent communication with those providers); and
- discussion of the international measures put in place by some OTT gaming providers, including the impacts these measures are having on network traffic and the information that OTT gaming providers have published about these measures.

nbn is continuing to make available information to all RSPs about relevant network and operational matters discussed by the Special Working Group and its sub-committees at regular intervals, including a communication issued to all RSPs regarding changes to the voluntary measures put in place by an OTT video streaming provider.
