

**Submission by alan Carlisle-4 December 2024**

As the past President of the “Redcliffe Aerodrome Chamber of Commerce Inc (RACCI) I make the following comments regarding Toowoomba City Airport's application for collective bargaining. In 2020 RACCI entered into negotiations with the Moreton Bay Regional Council with regard to renewing expired and current leases held at the Redcliffe Aerodrome. ACCC’s approval for collective bargaining proved to be the most efficient method for renewing aerodrome leases, providing for all leases to be renewed to a common expiry date, common dollar rates for all leaseholders and as common lease template to be drawn up. The approval for collective bargaining proved to be most efficient, in terms of Human Resources, time and money for Council and leaseholders. The aerodrome users at Redcliffe supports Toowoomba aerodrome leaseholders in their application for collective bargaining as this will result in the best outcomes for all parties.”
