Dear Rebecca and Susan,

Please accept our apologies for the slight delay in getting this to you.

Thank you for your call on 29 June 2020 asking for 7-Eleven's consent to the Commission making a public statement disclosing the duration of the agreements 7-Eleven has entered into with franchisees to temporarily reduce trading hours or temporarily close stores.

We are instructed by 7-Eleven that it consents to the Commission publicly disclosing the duration of the agreements. Based on the signed agreements we have provided to the Commission to date, the duration of the signed agreements to temporarily reduce store trading hours is 4 weeks and around 8 weeks to 12 weeks for agreements to temporarily close stores.

As the Commission may recall, the signed agreements for a temporary reduction in trading hours included a clause allowing the franchisees and 7-Eleven to extend the agreement by 4 weeks if both parties agree. The agreement may be further extended with the mutual consent of both parties.
