It is apparent that significant industry changes are pending regarding the delivery of quality medical care in Australia.

It is notable that there has been an equally significant lack of notice to key stakeholders - those clinicians who care for actual patients day to day.

I would request a review of the timeline, and a transparent and widespread distribution of this campaign - particularly to those Australian clinicians who currently keep their fellow Australians safe from the kind of 'care' we have all seen play out in countries.

Bundled health = reduced patient choice and reduced care giver autonomy. It also shifts increasing power to health insurers. I oppose NIB/Cigna/honeysuckle's proposal to create a buyers group and their intentions of bundled healthcare provision on the basis of limited transparency to key stakeholders and reduced choice and autonomy for Australian tax payers.
