Dear Mr Sims

I am Dr Shirley Prager Consultant Psychiatrist. I request that you consider my objections and those of many other Australians and Australian organisations and do not proceed with implementing your draft determination because of its foreseeable destructive consequences to vulnerable Australians who ACCC has a priority in protecting as stated on the ACCC website.

I have 2 major concerns about the ACCC Draft Determination Honeysuckle Health - Cigna and NIB if implemented.

1. I am concerned that Australia's health system both public and private will be destroyed. Health care decisions will be made by health bureaucrats not doctors. The priority will be profits of Cigna and NIB not the welfare of patients. The ACCC has an example of NIB putting profits before its duties to its members, actually on the ACCC website. Cigna is the subject of litigation in the USA.

2. Cigna is a large multinational company based in USA with a presence in China. I understand that through Cigna's data analytics program, Cigna will have access to My Health Record if the ACCC Draft Determination Honeysuckle Health is implemented. If this is correct, I am concerned that in the event of military conflict with China, China will have access to the Health Records of Australian defence forces. This would be a major threat to Australia's security.

Please put the interests of Australians first - our health and our national security as I understand is required by the ACCC.
