1. GC Green is an AdBlue manufacturer with sites in Sydney, Darwin and Townsville.
2. GC Green is involved in sourcing urea from Saudi Arabia, China and Vietnam. Once the raw material is received, GC Green then blends it into AdBlue and stores it. The AdBlue is then distributed by Brenntag Australia and Yara Australia.
3. The regulations in China around urea exports are always changing and unpredictable.
4. It is difficult to say whether there will continue to be issues in securing supply of urea and there can be a long lead time on receiving supply.
5. GC Green considers it will be useful to allow cooperation going forward while urea supplies and export restrictions continue to be uncertain.
