**Clean Energy Council's amended Solar Code – submission of Solar Victoria**

I refer to my letters dated 1 July 2020 and 2 September 2020 and your email dated 7 September 2020.

I am writing to confirm Solar Victoria's position with respect to the Clean Energy Council's submissions and proposed amendments to the Solar Retailer Code of Conduct (Solar Code) following the ACCC's Draft Determination dated 13 August 2020 (Draft Determination).


Solar Victoria continues to support the ACCC's proposed condition for re-authorisation of the Solar Code as outlined in the Draft Determination.

With respect to the duration of re-authorisation of the Solar Code, the proposed exclusion periods for rejected applicants, the mechanism for an appeals process for rejected applicants, and proposed updates to the privacy provisions of the Solar Code, I refer to and repeat Solar Victoria's submissions outlined in my letter dated 2 September 2020.

Solar Victoria makes no submission in relation to the CEC's proposal to introduce fees for appeals, or in relation to the proposed updates to formalise the 12-month operating requirement for retailers seeking to become signatories to the Solar Code.
