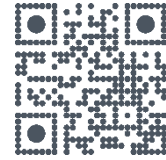

**Response to ACCC Question: Have you experienced, or do you expect to experience difficulties in encountering high quality feedstock in a future where SPSA or similar scheme, does not exist?**

In a future *without* the proposed Soft Plastics Stewardship Australia (SPSA), or similar scheme, iQRenew would expect to experience significant difficulties in accessing high-quality household soft plastic feedstock. Our SPEC facility, designed specifically to process household soft plastics would be unviable without the scheme in place.

A scheme is essential to ensuring a consistent supply of high-quality feedstock. Without it, not only would we struggle to access adequate material, but we would also lack sufficient demand for the processed product. In such a scenario, the material would effectively have no value, undermining the economic and environmental case for soft plastics recycling.

Soft plastics are a complex and persistent part of the waste stream. Addressing them requires long-term investment, stable funding, and strong collaboration between industry, government, and the community. An extended producer responsibility scheme is critical to create the economic conditions necessary to support and grow Australia's soft plastic processing infrastructure.

This issue is not going away. We must invest now in the systems and infrastructure that will support scalable processing.
