SUBJECT: ACCC Authorisation dated 29 October 2020 related to application AA1000527-1 granted to Ingham's, Turosi, Hazeldene's, and ACMF (Authorisation)

Weekly report under paragraph 11 of the Interim Authorisation Date: 13 November 2020

1. Background:

- 1) On 29 October 2020 the ACCC granted the Authorisation.
- 2) Capitalised terms not defined in this report have the meaning given to them in the Authorisation.
- 3) Paragraph 5.13 of the Authorisation provides:

(1) Reporting obligations

The Parties provide a report to the ACCC on a weekly basis (or as otherwise agreed by the ACCC) setting out details of each material decision made by the COVID Working Group (as defined in paragraph 1.5 above) which involves or otherwise relates to the Authorised Conduct. The ACCC will publish the reports subject to the assessment of any confidentiality claim.

On the 11th November the ACCC agreed to amend the reporting frequency to fortnightly for the remainder of the Authorisation.

(2) Provision of further information

The Parties provide any further information that the ACCC reasonably requests (through a contact person nominated by the Parties) about the Authorised Conduct being engaged in under the authorisation.

2. Weekly Report for the week 5 – 11 November 2020

During the period 5 - 11 November 2020 there were no meetings that involved all Processors. Three bilateral discussions took place during this reporting period. These discussions resulted in bilateral commercial arrangements between Processors regarding the purchase and sale of various chicken meat products to be used for their own individual demand.
