

## Competition and Consumer Act 2010

### Notice of extension of an access determination under subsection 152BCF(10)

1) Pursuant to subsection 152BCF(10) of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010 (Act)* the *Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (ACCC)* declares that the expiry date for each of:

- final access determination No. 2 of 2019 (local carriage service)
- final access determination No. 3 of 2019 (fixed originating access service)
- final access determination No. 4 of 2019 (fixed terminating access service)
- final access determination No. 6 of 2019 (wholesale line rental)
- final access determination No. 7 of 2019 (wholesale ADSL)
- final access determination No. 1 of 2020 (mobile terminating access service)

(collectively, the Final Access Determinations),

is taken to be the day immediately before the day on which each of the next corresponding Final Access Determinations come into force, which are currently the subject of the public inquiry that the ACCC commenced on 21 June 2024 under Part 25 of the *Telecommunications Act 1997* in accordance with section 152BCI of the Act.

2) For the avoidance of doubt, each reference to '30 June 2024' in each of the schedules to the Final Access Determinations is to be read as reference to the day immediately before the day on which the next final access determination comes into force, which are currently subject of the public inquiry that the ACCC has commenced on 21 June 2024, under Part 25 of the *Telecommunications Act 1997*, in accordance with section 152 BCI of the Act.
