Exemption from provisions of the *Competition and Consumer (Consumer Data Right) Rules 2020*


1. The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the Commission), pursuant to section 56GD(2) of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (the Act), hereby exempts

Avenue Bank Limited (ACN 628 073 085)

as a data holder, from the following provision(s) of the *Competition and Consumer (Consumer Data Right) Rules 2020* (the Rules):

- a) Rule 2.4(3) of Part 2 of the Rules (the obligation to disclose required product data in response to a product data request) and all related rules;
 - b) Rule 3.4(3) of Part 3 of the Rules (the obligation to disclose required consumer data in relation to a consumer data request made by an eligible consumer) and all related rules; and
 - c) Rule 4.6(4) of Part 4 of the Rules (the obligation to disclose required consumer data in relation to a consumer data request made by an accredited person) and all related rules.
2. This exemption applies until 31 July 2024.
 3. This exemption is effective from the date Avenue Bank Limited is granted an authority under section 9(3) of the *Banking Act 1959* (Cth) that is not subject to a time limit.
 4. In this instrument of exemption, the terms used have the meanings given in the Rules and the Act.
