Exemption from provisions of the Competition and Consumer (Consumer Data Right) Rules 2020

1. The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the Commission), pursuant to section 56GD(2) of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (the Act), hereby exempts

Locality Planning Energy Pty Ltd ("LPE") (ABN 15 148 958 061)

as a data holder, from the following provisions of the *Competition and Consumer* (Consumer Data Right) Rules 2020 (the Rules):

- (a) Rule 4.6(4) of Part 4 of the Rules (the obligation to disclose required consumer data in relation to a consumer data request made by an accredited person), and all related rules.
- 2. It is a condition of the exemption that LPE must notify the Commission in writing, as soon as practicable, of any of the following events occurring:
 - (a) LPE's customer numbers reach 10,000 small customers; or
 - (b) LPE makes an application to be an accredited person under rule 5.2 of the Rules.
- 3. It is also a condition of the exemption that LPE provides a notification to the Commission if it wishes Part 4 of the Rules to apply to it on and from a specified date.
- 4. In this instrument of exemption, the terms used have the meanings given in the Rules and the Act.
