

COMPETITION AND CONSUMER ACT 2010

Section 56GD(2)

Exemption from provisions of the *Competition and Consumer (Consumer Data Right) Rules 2020*

1. The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the Commission), pursuant to section 56GD(2) of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (the Act), hereby
(i) exempts

Indue Ltd (ABN 97 987 822 464)

as a data holder, from the following provisions of the *Competition and Consumer (Consumer Data Right) Rules 2020* (the Rules):

- (a) Rule 2.4(3) of Part 2 (the obligation to disclose required product data in relation to a product data request) and all related rules;
 - (b) Rule 3.4(3) of Part 3 of the Rules (the obligation to disclose required consumer data in relation to a consumer data request made by an eligible consumer), and all related rules;
 - (c) Rule 4.6(4) of Part 4 (the obligation to disclose required consumer data in relation to a consumer data request made by an accredited person), and all related rules.
- (ii) revokes the Exemption from provisions of the Rules granted to Indue Ltd on 18 June 2020.
2. The exemption in clause 1(i) applies until 30 June 2025.
 3. In this instrument of exemption, the terms used have the meanings given in the Rules and the Act.
