Exemption from provisions of the Competition and Consumer (Consumer Data Right) Rules 2020

- 1. The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the Commission), pursuant to section 56GD(2) of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010*, hereby
 - (i) exempts

Traditional Credit Union Limited (ABN 50 087 650 922)

as a data holder, from the following provisions of the Competition and Consumer (Consumer Data Right) Rules 2020 (the Rules):

- a) Rule 3.4(3) of Part 3 of the Rules (the obligation to disclose required consumer data in relation to a consumer data request made by an eligible consumer), and all related rules; and
- b) Rule 4.6(4) of Part 4 (the obligation to disclose required consumer data in relation to a consumer data request made by an accredited person), and all related rules.
- (ii) revokes the Exemption from provisions of the Rules granted to Traditional Credit Union on 10 June 2021.
- 2. The exemption in clause 1(i) applies until 30 June 2025.
- 3. In this instrument of exemption, the terms used have the meanings given in the Rules and the Act.
