

**Competition and Consumer Act 2010**


**Notice of extension of an access determination under subsection 152BCF(10)**

1. Pursuant to subsection 152BCF(10) of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (the Act), the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (ACCC) declares that the expiry date for the Final Access Determination No. 1 of 2016 (DTCS) is taken to be the day immediately before the day on which the next final access determination comes into force, which is currently the subject of the public inquiry that the ACCC commenced on 5 June 2019 under Part 25 of the *Telecommunications Act 1997* in accordance with section 152BCI of the Act.

Note: Clause 3 of Final Access Determination No. 1 of 2016 (DTCS) provides that it commenced on 21 April 2016 and remains in force up to and including 31 December 2019.

2. For avoidance of doubt, each reference to "31 December 2019" in Final Access Determination No. 1 of 2016 (DTCS) including its Schedules is to be read as a reference to "the day immediately before the day on which the next final access determination comes into force, which is currently the subject of the public inquiry that the ACCC commenced on 5 June 2019 under Part 25 of the *Telecommunications Act 1997* in accordance with section 152BCI of the Act".
