Extension of access determination in accordance with subsection 152BCF(10)

Pursuant to subsection 152BCF(10) of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010 (Act)*, the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the Commission) declares that the expiry date for the Final Access Determination No. 2 of 2012 for the Local Bitstream Access Service (LBAS) is taken to be the day immediately before the day on which the next Final Access Determination for the LBAS comes into force.

The Commission commenced an access determination inquiry for the LBAS on 7 April 2015 under part 25 of the *Telecommunications Act 1997* in accordance with section 152BCI of the Act.

Note: On 23 September 2015, the ACCC decided to extend the period by which it must make a Final Access Determination for the LBAS to 7 April 2016.
