**Section 56GD(2)**

**Exemption from provisions of the *Competition and Consumer  
(Consumer Data Right) Rules 2020***


1. The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the Commission), pursuant to section 56GD(2) of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (the Act), hereby exempts

**Arab Bank Australia Limited (ABN 37 002 950 745)**

as a data holder from the following provisions of the *Competition and Consumer (Consumer Data Right) Rules 2020* (the Rules):

- a) Rule 3.4(3) of Part 3 of the Rules (the obligation to disclose required consumer data in relation to a consumer data request made by an eligible consumer) as it relates to consumer data requests in relation to joint accounts, CDR consumers that are not individuals, or that are partnerships, nominated representatives and secondary users, and all related rules; and
  - b) Rule 4.6(4) of Part 4 of the Rules (the obligation to disclose required consumer data in relation to a consumer data request made by an accredited person) as it relates to consumer data requests in relation to joint accounts, CDR consumers that are not individuals, or that are partnerships, nominated representatives and secondary users, and all related rules;
2. The exemption applies until 31 May 2023.
  3. In this instrument of exemption, the terms used have the meanings given in the Rules and the Act.
