COMPETITION AND CONSUMER ACT 2010

Section 56GD(2)

Exemption from provisions of the Competition and Consumer (Consumer Data Right) Rules 2020

- 1. The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the Commission), pursuant to section 56GD(2) of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (the Act), hereby:
 - (i) exempts

Bendigo and Adelaide Bank Limited (ACN 068 049 178)

as a data holder, from the following provisions of the *Competition and Consumer* (Consumer Data Right) Rules 2020 (the Rules):

- (a) Rule 3.4(3) of Part 3 of the Rules (the obligation to disclose required consumer data in relation to a consumer data request made by an eligible consumer) and all related rules; and
- (b) Rule 4.6(4) of Part 4 of the Rules (the obligation to disclose required consumer data in relation to a consumer data request made by an accredited person) and all related rules,

to the extent that these provisions would apply to the CDR data described in clause 2 of this instrument.

- (ii) amends the exemption instrument for the Exemption granted to Bendigo and Adelaide Bank Limited dated 22 September 2022 to revoke:
 - (a) clause 2(b) and clause 4, in relation to required consumer data for products of the Rural Bank brand; and
 - (b) clause 2(c) and clause 5, in relation to required consumer data for products of Adelaide Bank however branded.
- 2. The CDR data that is the subject of this instrument is:
 - (a) required consumer data for products of the Rural Bank brand; and
 - (b) required consumer data for products of Adelaide Bank however branded.
- 3. A reference to "related rules" for the purpose of this instrument means:
 - (a) in respect to rule 3.4(3): rule 1.13(1);
 - (b) in respect to rule 4.6(4): rules 1.13(1), 1.15(1), 1.15(5), 4.5(3), 4A.5(2), 4A.6(1), 4A.14(2), 4A.14(3).

- 4. The exemption granted in respect of the data described in clause 2(a) applies until 30 November 2024.
- 5. The exemption granted in respect of the data described in clause 2(b) applies until:
 - a. 30 June 2024 for new and refinanced brokered customers; and
 - b. 31 December 2025 for existing brokered customers and white-labelled products.
- 6. In this instrument of exemption, the terms used have the meanings given in the Rules and the Act.
